INTRODUCTION

If you're like me, you've struggled a lot, failed a lot, or messed up a lot. And it's easy to get tired from the struggle. But the truth is, we shouldn't have to claw and fight to overcome sin, experience God's love, or get God to keep His promises. That's what grace is all about. Nothing we do or haven't done can change what Jesus already did on the cross for us.

In this devotional, you're going to discover that God is committed to keeping His promises to you—no matter how far you've fallen, how often you've failed, or where you're at in life. God doesn't need our holiness to prove His holiness. He doesn't need our promises to keep His promises. The struggle is over, Jesus did it all...

Enjoy these pearls of pure grace that will bring you into a place of peace and rest beginning today!

FAITH RESTS

So that your faith would not rest on the wisdom of men, but on the power of God.

1 Corinthians 2:5 (NASB)

What is the power of God? According to 1 Corinthians 1:18 the CROSS is the power of God. What Jesus did on the cross is what brings God's power into our lives. We can't beg enough, pay enough or be holy enough to bring God's power into our lives. It comes through faith in the Cross. Believe today that the finished work of the Cross will bring power into whatever you're facing. Jesus said to "take up your cross daily". Each day we can say, "My faith rests in the the power of the cross today to bring healing, wholeness and victory in every area of my life." This will bring you true rest.

JESUS DID IT ALL

When Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "It is finished!" And He bowed His head and gave up His spirit.

John 19:30 (NASB)

The last 3 words that Jesus spoke on the cross echo in eternity! What was finished? Jesus fulfilled all the law, paid all the debt of our sin, took all of our pain, became a curse for us, and in return, gives us complete forgiveness, the gift of righteousness, healing, the blessing, and the promises of God! He drank the bitter wine of the curse, so we could drink the sweet wine of the blessing. That's the grace of God! What's not to love about a Savior like that? Meditate on this great exchange, and supernatural peace and rest will overtake your heart!

THE THRONE OF GRACE

So let's walk right up to Him and get what He is so ready to give. Take the mercy, accept the help.

Hebrews 4:16 (MSG)

Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Hebrews 4:16 (NKJV)

Take a fresh look at the throne of God's grace today. It will change you. God is SO READY to give us what we need. His throne does not dispense judgment or guilt to His child. For to those who are washed by the precious blood of Jesus, His throne dispenses nothing but grace—unlimited, unmerited, unmixed mercy and grace to help you in any and every area of life that you have need. So APPROACH boldly, this grace-filled throne. ASK boldly for what you need at this grace-filled throne. And ACCEPT boldly all that you have asked for at this grace-filled throne. He is SO ready to fill you, meet all your needs, and empower you today!

JESUS: YOUR SABBATH (REST)

Therefore do not let anyone judge you by what you eat or drink, or with regard to a religious festival, a New Moon celebration or a Sabbath day. These are a shadow of the things that were to come; the reality, however, is found in Christ.

Colossians 2:16-17 (NIV)

In the Old Testament, the Sabbath (Rest) was a DAY. But in the New Testament, the Sabbath is a PERSON! God created the Sabbath under the Old Covenant to point His people to a day where they could cease striving and trust in His provision. Well, Jesus is now our Sabbath. We no longer have to set aside one day a week, to cease from striving and trusting God; but now it's a lifestyle to cease striving and know that He will provide our every need. What Jesus did on the cross empowers us to cease striving to be saved. He saves us. We cease striving to be healed. He heals us. And we cease striving to get God to keep His promises. He is watching over His Word to perform it.

TAKE YOUR RIGHTFUL SEAT

And God raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus.

Ephesians 2:6 (NASB)

Notice here that God has raised us up with Jesus Christ AND seated us with Him! Jesus is seated at the right hand of the Father. He is not standing as if there is work left for Him to do regarding our salvation, blessing, and dominion. He is seated, which represents a position of rest. He has finished all that needs to be done for us to have salvation, blessing, and dominion. He is seated in His finished position, and we are now seated with Him! Rest in this truth today.

UNDER GRACE

Sin can't tell you how to live (anymore). After all, you're not living under that old tyranny (of the law) any longer. You're living in the freedom of God.

Romans 6:14 (The MSG)

Sin doesn't tell you how to live anymore! That means you are no longer taking your orders and direction from sin. When Jesus became sin for us on the cross, it lost its dominion and power over us. It lost its right to dictate our destiny. We are not under the law, we are under the grace of God now. The grace of God (His unconditional love and unmerited favor) is in you, changing you, leading you, and creating a future for you beyond your wildest dreams! Today, believe that the grace of God is working in you to live the life of God, just like Jesus did.

YOU ARE ON TOP

And the LORD shall make you the head, and not the tail; and you shalt be above only, and you shalt not be beneath...

Deuteronomy 28:13 (KJV)

What an awesome description of our authority in this life! It should give us rest to know that we don't have to strive to get on top, to have dominion, or to experience victory. In Christ, we are already on top. We already have dominion over the enemy, and we have the victory. Adam and Eve were given dominion when God created them and placed them in the garden. They lost it all when they believed the lie of the enemy. But Jesus came to destroy the works of the devil and take back the dominion that was lost. Then He gave it to us! Let's live from this position of authority where life flows much easier

FAITH IS THE VICTORY

For whatever is born of God overcomes the world; and this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith.

1 John 5:4 (NASB)

This amazing promise shows us that we already have the victory. So many believers get weary and struggle because they're trying to obtain something they already have. That would wear anyone out! But God shows us here that our faith in what Jesus already did, and our faith in God's Word, IS the victory. We HAVE ALREADY overcome the world! Rejoice today because you have the victory over sin, sickness, and the devil. We no longer fight FOR this place of victory; we fight FROM this place of victory. And simply believe we have received it!

HIS YOKE IS EASY

Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you, and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart; and you shall find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy, and My load is light.

Matthew 11:28-30 (NASB)

What a Grand Invitation! Jesus promises rest twice in this verse. There can be NO DOUBT that His will for us is to live in His rest. A yoke connects two oxen and enables the younger, weaker ox to be helped by the stronger ox. Jesus is the strong ox, and by being yoked to Him, we will easily get to His destination for our lives. To be yoked to Him means to receive Him, to agree with His Word, and to say what He says. As we do this, we will find the Christian life to be a joy-filled journey, in spite of our circumstances and trials.

THE FIGHT IS OVER

"Comfort, O comfort My people," says your God. "Speak kindly to Jerusalem; And call out to her, that her warfare has ended, That her iniquity has been removed, That she has received of the LORD'S hand Double for all her sins."

Isaiah 40:1-2 (NASB)

What a picture of what Jesus does for us! He removes our iniquities; He restores what was lost, because of our sins; He comforts us by the Holy Spirit. What a Lord! What a Savior! Notice the announcement that our warfare is over. We don't have to defeat sin, sickness, or the devil. Jesus defeated them. That warfare is over. Our battle now is simply to resist the devil and resist what he throws our way. How do we resist the enemy? With the Word of God, just as Jesus did. Speak God's Word and trust that it will not return void. It is with the sword of the Spirit, the Word of God, that we enforce our victory in spiritual warfare, pulling down strongholds. The war is already won because Jesus has paid the full price.

HIS VICTORY IS YOUR VICTORY

For we who have believed enter that rest, just as He has said, "As I swore in My wrath, they shall not enter My rest," although His works were finished from the foundation of the world.

Hebrews 4:3 (NASB)

God wants us to rest from our struggle with sin and our struggle to see God's promises fulfilled in our lives. How does that happen? As we believe in the finished work of the cross, we enter into true rest. We grow weary when we try to do what Jesus already did. He conquered sin. He guaranteed His promises with His precious blood. There's nothing we have to add to it. His victory is NOW our victory. As we believe it, we experience true peace and triumph over opposition. Rest in this truth today!

HIS PROMISE NEVER FAILS

Blessed be the LORD, who has given rest to His people Israel, according to all that He promised. There has not failed one word of all His good promise, which He promised through His servant Moses.

1 Kings 8:56 (NKJV)

As I've said many times, the Christian life is not based on the promises we make to God, but rather upon the promises He makes to us. This fundamental shift in our thinking will bring true rest and peace in our lives. God's promises produce rest. Peace will flood our hearts when we accept the glorious truth that not one of God's promises has failed to come to pass—not one! If God kept His promises to the Old Covenant people, you can be absolutely sure He will keep His promises to you, who are under a New Covenant—made by Him and kept by Him!

RECEIVE THE GIFT OF REST

Blessed be the LORD, who has given rest to His people Israel, according to all that He promised. There has not failed one word of all His good promise, which He promised through His servant Moses.

1 Kings 8:56 (NKJV)

There is another hidden truth in the middle of this verse that I want us to meditate on today. He says here, "The Lord GIVES rest to His people." God is saying REST is a GIFT. He GIVES rest. It's not earned. It's not worked for. It's given as a gift to God's people. The moment we are born again, we immediately become part of God's chosen people. And this gift of rest—from our struggles and battles—is ours. Just ask God for it right now. And begin to thank God for it. Things will change!

THE WORD WILL DO THE REST

This is what the kingdom of God is like. A man scatters seed on the ground. Night and day, whether he sleeps or gets up, the seed sprouts and grows, though he does not know how. All by itself, it produces grain.

Mark 4:26-28 (NIV)

Remember that the kingdom of God is not a place. (Although Heaven is absolutely a place!) God's Kingdom is His way of doing things. We will constantly live in frustration and disappointment when we try to get God's results, but continue to do things our own way, rather than God's way. It will also wear us out when we try to do God's job for Him. He's really good at doing His job! Our job is to plant the seed of God's Word in our heart, through our mouths, in our families, and over anything that concerns us. The Word, once sown, will grow and do the rest!

THE PILLOW OF GOD'S PROMISES

Jesus said, "Let us cross over to the other side . . ." And a great windstorm arose, and the waves beat into the boat, so that it was already filling. But He was in the stern, asleep on a pillow. And they awoke Him and said to Him, "Teacher, do You not care that we are perishing?"

Mark 4:35, 37-38 (NKJV)

Well, the greater storm wasn't in the sea; it was in the hearts and minds of the disciples! How is it that Jesus could sleep in the midst of the storm, but the disciples could only worry and fear? Because Jesus declared a promise! And He always keeps His promises. He told them that they were going to the other side. And no matter what came their way, they were going to get there. He knew they would make it. And they did! Rest on the pillow of God's promises, and you will make it to the other side of whatever you're facing today

GOD RESTORES YOU

I'll refresh tired bodies; I'll restore tired souls.

Jeremiah 31:25 (MSG)

God doesn't expect us to restore ourselves. He is the God of restoration. He says that He will restore our health, our fortunes, and our years that have been devoured and stolen. He does that by restoring our soul. As we lie down beside the green pastures of His grace and the still waters of His promises, He restores our soul! (Psalm 23:2-3) From a restored soul, flows all the restoration that He has promised. Our lives prosper as our souls prosper. (3 John 2) Renew your mind to God's way of thinking today, and He will refresh, restore, and transform your life effortlessly!

WHAT DO YOU SEE?

The word of the LORD came to me saying, "What do you see, Jeremiah?" And I said, "I see a rod of an almond tree." Then the LORD said to me, "You have seen well, for I am watching over My word to perform it."

Jeremiah 1:11-12 (NASB)

God wants us to get focused on what His Word says. That's where rest and peace come from. What do you see? Never take your eyes off of His promises. He is watching over His Word to perform it. SO often, we feel WE have to perform to get God's Word to work. But God is the performer, not us. Believe it. Speak it. Trust God to bring it to pass. Yes, it's that simple! What do you do in the meantime when you don't see it in the natural? Keep looking at God's promise and thanking Him that He will perform it.

HE WILL KEEP YOU

You will keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You.

Isaiah 26:3 (NKJV)

What a relief to know that it is the Lord who will KEEP US in perfect peace. Many believers are missing this simple truth. We don't have to try to find peace and rest. All we have to do is get our mind stayed on Him. Flood your mind today with the Word of God and with His promises. Then, peace and rest will come to you! The DNA of perfect peace is in the Word. As we meditate on it, the DNA of perfect peace is released in our lives.

GRACE & PEACE MULTIPLIED

Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord.

2 Peter 1:2 (NKJV)

Who couldn't use more grace and peace in their life? Grace is God's unmerited love and favor. And peace is the blessing of wholeness, health, prosperity, and victory. Notice that God is not saying that there is anything we can do to get Him to give us more grace and peace. He is saying that grace and peace will abundantly increase in our lives, through the knowledge of who God is and what He has ALREADY done for us through Jesus Christ. The more we understand the finished work of Jesus, the more grace and peace are multiplied in our lives. Rest in this truth.

ENJOY THE GIFT OF RIGHTEOUSNESS

And the effect of righteousness will be peace [internal and external], and the result of righteousness will be quietness and confident trust forever. My people shall dwell in a peaceable habitation, in safe dwellings, and in quiet resting-places.

Isaiah 32:17-18 (AMPC)

The first thing we see here is that rest, peace, and confidence are the overflow of righteousness. This is a simple cause and effect. As we understand the gift of righteousness freely given to us in Christ, then rest, peace, and confidence flow from that. Righteousness is "to be made right with God through the blood of Jesus" and to, therefore, stand before God without guilt, fear, or condemnation. The more we understand this amazing gift, the more confident trust grows in our lives.

SIMPLY BELIEVE TODAY

They replied, "We want to perform God's works, too. What should we do?" Jesus told them, "This is the only work God wants from you: Believe in the one He has sent."

John 6:28-29 (NLT)

Inside the heart of every believer is the desire to do the works of God and to do what God wants them to do. But Jesus could not be more clear. Our WORK is to believe. Our FIGHT is the fight of faith—to believe that Jesus did it all to secure God's inheritance and covenant promises with us. We were designed by God to trust Him and believe His Word. God is saying, "My child, I will perform the works that you need. I will fulfill My promises. I will supply all your needs. Your work is to believe and trust." That's a pretty great deal God makes with us, isn't it? He does the heavy lifting. We do the believing.

GOD IS FIGHTING FOR YOU

He said, "Listen, all you people of Judah and Jerusalem! Listen, King Jehoshaphat! This is what the LORD says: Do not be afraid! Don't be discouraged by this mighty army, for the battle is not yours, but God's."

2 Chronicles 20:15 (NLT)

Notice what happens when we truly believe that the battle is not ours, but the Lord's. Fear leaves. Discouragement leaves. And even in the face of overwhelming odds against us, we win! The secret to a fear-free life is to know that God has fought and is fighting for you. We don't live in our strength, but God's. How many times have you felt discouraged when you looked at what you were up against? Next time you feel that way, declare at that moment: the battle is the Lord's, and He wins every battle He is in!

THE POWER OF GOD'S PRESENCE

And He said, "My presence shall go with you, and I will give you rest."

Exodus 33:14 (NASB)

The presence of God makes all the difference in our lives! True peace and rest is not the absence of problems and storms, but rather the presence of God in the midst of those problems and storms. David said, "You prepare a table for me in the presence of my enemies." (Psalm 23:5) We don't have to worry and scurry to get rid of all our enemies before we have peace. We can sit at the table of God's presence no matter what is going on in our lives. We can come boldly into His presence through the precious blood of Jesus. (Hebrews 10:19) You are the temple of the Holy Spirit. He lives in you! God's presence goes where you go—so there's nothing to fear!

HIS COVENANT OF PEACE

"For the mountains shall depart and the hills be removed, but My kindness shall not depart from you, nor shall My covenant of peace be removed," says the LORD, who has mercy on you.

Isaiah 54:10 (NKJV)

Did you know that God has made a covenant with you? His covenant is an unbreakable contract that has been sealed through the blood of Jesus Christ. That means that no matter what happens in this world, and no matter what anyone does to you, God will back up His oath, sworn in blood, to protect you, and give you peace (which means: wholeness, prosperity, health, and victory)!

A GREAT CALM

And He arose and rebuked the wind and said to the sea, Hush now! Be still (muzzled)! And the wind ceased (sank to rest as if exhausted by its beating) and there was [immediately] a great calm (a perfect peacefulness).

Mark 4:39 (AMPC)

Jesus used His authority and spoke to the sea! There are many storms that may be beating against your life today. But you too have the authority to rebuke the wind and speak to the storms of your life. They too will come to rest around you rather than rage against you. 1 John 4:17 says, "as He is, so are we in this life." We can deal with the storms, as Jesus did. Use this awesome gift of speaking God's Word. You can stop talking about your storm and start talking to it. Things will change.

MIRACLES AMONG YOU

Does God give you the Holy Spirit and work miracles among you because you obey the law? Of course not! It is because you believe the message you heard about Christ.

Galatians 3:5 (NLT)

The first thing we learn from this verse is God is STILL working miracles among us! But our mistakes and shortcomings don't disqualify us from God's power working in our lives. Many people think God is holding back His miracles, His answers, and His promises because of something they've done wrong. But it is not our holiness that qualifies us for God's power, just as it is not our unholiness that disqualifies us. Now, if we are choosing to sin, we need to receive God's forgiveness and repent; however, there is no way to cross every "T" to receive God's miracle power. Jesus crossed the only "T" necessary when He died on the cross! Our faith in that work on the cross causes His miracle works to invade our lives. Expect His miracle-working power in your life today!

UNLEASH THE POWER

And Stephen, full of grace and power, was doing great wonders and signs among the people.

Acts 6:8 (ESV)

Stephen was not one of the twelve apostles, and yet, that didn't limit him from experiencing the fullness of God's grace and power. And it doesn't have to limit you either. Notice in this verse: it is the grace that preceded the power. When we awaken to God's unconditional love and unmerited favor toward us and in us, it produces a power that unleashes the supernatural signs and wonders of God. What often stops the flow of God's power in our lives is our own sense of unworthiness, condemnation, guilt, and shame. But all that is swallowed up by the blood of Jesus. Embrace grace and unleash the power!

HIS BREATH OF LOVE & GRACE

May our Lord Jesus Christ Himself and God our Father, who loved us and by His grace gave us eternal encouragement and good hope, encourage your hearts and strengthen you in every good deed and word.

2 Thessalonians 2:16-17 (NIV)

Our Heavenly Father adores us! God's love is never empty. He always loves with a gift. God SO loved that He gave. In other words, God SO loves, that He gives us His grace. He "graces" us with every gift we will ever need. Today, let's meditate on the four things in this verse that He gives us because He loves us. And let's set our expectation for these gifts to flow in and through our lives: encouragement, hope, strength, good deeds, and words. Yes, as we breathe in His love and grace today, fixing our minds on what Jesus did for us, we can expect to be flooded with: encouragement from the Spirit of God, hope that is fadeless, strength in the midst of our weakness, and godly fruit in our lives!

YOU HAVE POWER

For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

2 Timothy 1:7 (NKJV)

God knows what we will need in order to handle what He knows will come our way. Fear paralyzes and prevents us from walking in God's ultimate purpose for our lives. But, notice this three-strand cord that He gives or 'graces us' with to drive fear out of our lives. Fear comes when we feel powerless, so He gives us the POWER of the Holy Spirit. Fear comes when we feel unloved, so He gives us His perfect LOVE, which casts out fear! And fear comes when we don't know what to do or how to think. So He gives us a SOUND MIND—the mind of Christ and the ability to think His thoughts, through His Word. What a Father! What grace! What love! You have POWER!

UNDER THE TREE

Let a little water be brought, and you may wash your feet and recline and rest yourselves under the tree.

Genesis 18:4 (AMPC)

Ah, the rest that comes from being under the Tree! The cross is the tree that truly gives us rest. Let's live under the shadow of this TREE every day. This is the secret place of the Most High, where we abide under the shadow of the Almighty. It's here under the tree that we find rest from our search for love, healing, wisdom, and answers. Under the tree drips down covenant blessing after covenant blessing in the form of liquid love. Place your trust today under the TREE where Jesus' blood drips down and calms the raging seas in your heart and mind—where it heals you everywhere you're hurting by its precious and wondrous flow!

Receive Salvation

YOUR NEW LIFE BEGINS WITH GOD'S LOVE

This is the kind of love we are talking about—not that we once upon a time loved God—but that He loved us and sent His Son as a sacrifice to clear away our sins and the damage they've done to our relationship with God.

1 John 4:10b (The MSG)

Christianity is not a religion. It is a relationship between God and you.

God loves you deeply and wants a personal relationship with you! The Love of Jesus Christ will sweep away your sin, loneliness, pain, and fear. He wants you to spend eternity in Heaven with Him, and the rest of your life on this earth walking with Him. If you would like to begin a new life—beyond your wildest dreams and be born again—pray the following prayer, and believe in your heart that God answers!

"Heavenly Father, I believe that Jesus Christ died on the cross for my sins and rose from the dead. His blood washes away my past, my sins; and prepares me for eternity. I receive Your forgiveness and accept Jesus as my Savior and Lord. From this day forward, I am Yours, in Jesus' name. Amen!"
